## 1. Go to Process Course Results

#### 2. Locate the student and click their little i button

## 3. Click Undo Resit

This button will only appear if you're a superuser and the course result is not ratified.

If you're changing the first sit marks and the new result will create another resit record you should also unpublish the first sit result.

If you don't then when you ratify the new first sit result it may look like you can't publish it because the resit record will appear as soon as you ratify.
